- Killeen ISD offers differentiated academic instructions, pre-Advanced Placement, Advanced Placement, dual credit, & other advanced course offerings to G/T students.
- #4
- Students participating in G/T services are required to exhibit self-directed learning, thinking, and research and communication skills.
- #5
- All students availing G/T services are expected to participate in the Texas Performance Standards Project.
